

Scatterplot: when does it happen?

See the time of day a behavior clusters, over two weeks, before you look for why.

1. Each day, fill one box per half hour: blank = didn't happen, / = once or twice, X = three or more.
2. Draw a dash if the learner wasn't there, so an empty box always means it didn't happen.
3. After two weeks, look for rows that fill up. Take ABC data at those times next.
