

Task analysis data sheet

Break a skill into steps and score each step each session, so you teach only the steps that are missing.

- 1. Write one step per row: something you could see, starting with a verb.
- 2. Say the instruction once. Mark + if the step was done alone, – if it needed help or didn't happen.
- 3. Score = + steps ÷ all steps × 100, in the bottom row.
- 4. Stopping at the first – is the single-opportunity way; doing the step for them and going on is the multiple-opportunity way.
